## Three treated for protest injuries

Fifty-one protesters were arrested inside Munson Hall yesterday at 7:15 p.m. Nine others were arrested for sitting in front of a bus transporting those arrested to Hampshire County Jail, University of Massachusetts police said.

One of the protesters was treated and released for knee injuries at Cooley Dickinson Hospital. Two police officers were treated and released for bite injuries and one for a shoulder injury, police said.

● A female resident of Greenough House

reported an obscene phone call. The woman told police she heard a male "giving a description of his sexual desires," on her answering machine, police said.

● Two highway signs were reported "confiscated" by police from a second floor room of Brooks House at 1:04 a.m. yesterday, police said.
