Dear V.P.C.,

About a month ago I wrote you from Toronto suggesting that anyone you know coming to Toronto could use our address and stay with us. But we've now moved to Montreal because I plan to go to McGill University, hence we'll be of assistance only to those moving to Montreal.

Housing in Montreal is plentiful, but there are a couple hangups. One must sign a lease for at least a year (although I've heard that they're easy to break), and because of the lease, apts. usually are not available until the 1<sup>st</sup> of the month. Anyone moving to Montreal is advised to make a preliminary visit 2 or 3 weeks before immigrating in order to arrange for housing. Most places are unfurnished - no stove and no refrigerator (but used ones are cheap - \$25 each.)

Finding a job is unpleasant unless one is bilingual. Knowing French helps a lot.
